

# The Double-Handed Sailing Association's

Procedure for acceptance of a boat rating for DSA events:

1. DRYA certificate valid for that year.
2. Local PHRF certificate other than DRYA for home waters of yacht.
3. Rating issued in current US Sailing PHRF book
4. PHRF Book, for Detroit, then Lake Huron, then Lake Erie
5. Avg. of all PHRF Rating listed in PHRF Book.
6. Create rating from data and committee.

Procedure for applied credits:

**Roller furling Credit:** This credit will only be issued if sails and unit meet the DRYA roller furling credit specifications. The credit must be on the current valid certificate for the boat to be applied. If a yacht has a certificate from another racing area, that RF criteria for the credit must be met and on that current certificate.

**Propeller Credit:** This credit will only be issued if the unit meets the DRYA fixed propeller credit specifications. The credit must be on the current valid certificate for the boat to be applied. If a yacht has a certificate from another racing area, that fixed propeller credit criteria for the credit must be met and on that current certificate.

**Sail Material Credit:** This credit will only be issued if sails meet the DRYA credit specifications. The credit must be on the current valid certificate for the boat to be applied. If a yacht has a certificate from another racing area, that sail material criteria for the credit must be met and on that current certificate.
